Dear Dudley

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of October 22nd.

I can see no reason why an individual residing in a foreign country cannot Deed property to your corporation. A number of corporations of this country do hold title to property in foreign countries. However, I have never had any experience along this line and feel that you should obtain a little better opinion than mine.

In answer to your second question, I do not believe you could take over the laboratory by merely adding a name. I should think that some paper showing transfer would have to be drawn up before the title would be complete.

I am sorry I cannot give you definite and certain instructions on how to handle this matter, but I am unable to do so and would think you could find someone in New York who could straighten you out in your difficulty without a great amount of expense.
