My dear Mr. Shibayeff:

Mrs. Horch has brought to the New York Office the set of slides which you were so gracious to send as a gift to this institution here.

I am requested by the trustees of this institution to extend to you their appreciation of your splendid gift and wholehearted cooperation in our work.
