Dear Mr. Horch,

I have received your kind letter and I appreciated it indeed very much.

You are asking me about the condition of health of Mme. de Roerich and about possibilities of Urusvati.

I believe, that by this time, you have already received my official report regarding the state of Mme's Health, and at present I have nothing to add to it. Her disease is very interesting from the medical point of view and is quite rare. There is not very much to be done with medicines, but the most important point is to keep her away from any possible excitement, because here psychic nature is so closely related through her sensibilized peripheral nervous system to the internal organs, especially to the heart, that any psychic trauma can be fatal. Moreover, she presents some symptoms of cardiac asthma, which aggravates the condition.

It is difficult for me to judge about the possibilities of Urusvati. Of course, there could be done much of a scientific work in respect of botany, biology, geology, meteorology, etc. As to the medicine, we really need a small hospital to make observations. But this scientific work is so handicapped now by external conditions that until they are removed a mutual good faith with the local authorities established and conditions for a quiet scientific

work created, it is difficult to foresee how useful can become
Ursvati for the scientific work. I can only say that every-
body here is enthusiastic for high ideals of science and spirit
and will do everything to promote the knowledge, which can be
beneficial for humanity.
