I returned to my country some days ago, and my first and most pleasant duty is to express you my heartiest gratitude for the kind reception you honored me with, for which I shall always be grateful to you.

To my great regret, by reason of the forth coming Parliamentary elections in Bulgaria as well as the sudden death of my Sister, I was obliged to adjourn my scientific work in America and come back home.

But I shall remember with greatest pleasure your dear hospitality. I should be very grateful to you if you would kindly advise me what is to be done on my part to become a member of your Society. I speak here with greatest admiration for and praise of the organization and the activity of your Museum and beg you forward me all the printed matters edited by it.

I hope next October to be again in America in order to continue my scientific work which I adjourned and I believe I shall then have the opportunity of seeing you again and calling up on you. Meanwhile, I would ask your advice as to what it is possible to be done towards the organization of a Bulgarian exhibition in the halls of your Museum.

Will you also tell me if you received a letter of mine to you in Russian, sent you through the kindness of a lady.

Kindly greet in my name all your friends to whom you had the goodness to introduce me. Also will you please send me all your printed matter which you did not give me during my last sojourn with you as also your photo. This last I shall preserve as a choice souvenir.
