Dear Mrs. Fosdick:

Excuse the delay in answering your letter of 27 May. My wife and I have just completed the 10,000 miles motor trip of the USA - which took us south and then to California before we got home. I really went to see if the PEOPLE of the USA were as warlike as one might imagine from reading the U S warmongering press. My conclusion was NO-- the people are not -- but they are very confused and misinformed by their press.

Up here in Canada I think we are a bit better balanced - perhaps more accurately not so badly misinformed by our press.

It was nice of you to write those nice things about my visit and writings to Mme Roerich, Yes I knew of her place. Although you did not mention it, I assumed that was her portrait near the one where the messenger is coming across the bridge to the woman, humanity.

Was quite interested to note Pegler's recent blasts at Prof. Roerich. Evidently those for whom Pegler speaks are willing to go to desperate lengths to try and discredit the R. Mission.

Enclosed are extra copies of the article you asked about. All my daily writings appear in several Canadian newspapers - also one per week in about 12 good weeklies. For one year the same articles also appeared in 14 US west coast papers - but the U S press is not open now to anyone who holds our ideas as to necessity of achieving a basis of live and let live with Russia -- and for that matter, with all the great members of the human family.

Perhaps you could send me with the "Master" also anything else that the enclosed stamps will cover.
