Dear Dr. Lukins:

During the past four years I have taken charge of selling the Russian publications which you have sent from Riga, addressed to Agni Yoga publications and to Sina Lichtman, and in response to the recent letter of Mr. Ansevics, I have gone thoroughly over the records of these sales.

It appears that we owe you \$17.35, according to a bill which you sent us on March 15, 1938. At that time you requested us to postpone the sending of this money, as you apparently wanted us to continue sending you our books in exchange for your books which you were sending to us. This sum of \$17.35 was put aside by me and I find it best to send it to you at this time so as to clear up this bill in our books.

I also find it necessary at this writing to ask you to send to us a detailed statement of books sent and received during this period of years under an exchange agreement--that is, the amount of books which we have sent you and the amount you have sent us in exchange.

We shall then learn very definitely as to whether the exchange agreement between you and us has been completed--that is, whether there is no indebtedness on our side or whether there is a certain sum still outstanding, in which case we should like to know about it at present.
