I am herewith resigning from the Agni Yoga Committee.

I am transmitting to you all correspondence, books and data which pertain to the Agni Yoga Publications. The Agni Yoga Publication books are in the closets of room 414. The keys to the room are in your possession. Miss Grant and Mr. Lichtmann also were given keys to this room.

Kindly sign the receipt for the various papers and documents which I have sent to you through William Wood.

The bank accounts are balanced and the daily ledger contains all current accounts. The present bank balance is \$180.20.

I do not intend to take an inventory of the Agni Yoga Publication books in the closets as there are such quantities of the Yiddish, Russian and French books which are practically inactive. In addition, no secretarial or other allowances were granted for executive work in connection with the sale and care of these books. My office has contributed secretarial and other help gratis from May to present date to carry on the executive work of the Agni Yoga Publications when Mrs. Campbell discontinued this work, last spring.

I am now turning this matter over to you as representative of Professor Roerich.

Yesterday you refused to take the Agni Yoga material which I transmitted to you. Hence all correspondence and orders will remain inactive until I am directed by you to whom to turn over this material.
