My quadrennial leave has been granted for 1934 - '35. I shall probably be going out to Asia about June 1st, returning near the 1st of February. As now planned my itinerary will include Mongolia, Turkestan, Persia, India, in the order named. I shall probably be doing some lecturing in Universities in India in October and November, 1934.

Your staff can give me valuable information concerning both Mongolia and India, I am sure. It is barely possible that I may be able to run up to New York from Washington about Dec. 23rd. I should very much like to see all of you before leaving for the East.
