1) The white woolled large leaved variety. Flower heads concealed numerous small (usually). Central flower head not much larger than others. Flowers deep purple black.

They may be large or small usually. Form dense radical rosette of leaves. Their leaves are green wool very thick. Leaves above glabrous with tows on undersurface and fine hairs on upper. Rootstock usually long spongy, not much divided.

2). Wool usually white rarely pruinose. Leaves ~~rarely~~ ~~pin~~ almost entire or remotely footed ^{head}. One large central flower and few small ones around it. After central flower head is anti they dead.

Leaves are fewer and usually clusters round flower. They are often 3, 6, 7 or more in ones
