Dear Sir:

Some time ago I wrote to your Department of Corporations, inquiring about the date of incorporation of URUSVATI HIMALAYAN RESEARCH INSTITUTE. I also asked if it was possibly incorporated under the name URUSVATI HIMALAYAN AMERICAN SCIENTIFIC STATION.

I understand that this institution was incorporated under the education law of the State of New York, and it probably was done about eight years ago. This is an affiliated institution of the Roerich Museum, and all papers about it are probably on record in your office together with other papers of institutions affiliated with Roerich Museum.

I will appreciate any information you can give me on this matter, and if a charter was granted I will be willing to pay for a copy of it, as I wish to know its officers, date of incorporation, date of dissolution if it was dissolved, and exact name on record.

In answer to my previous inquiries I received a letter stating that there was no record in Albany of either of the two names mentioned above. Therefore I am now suggesting that it might possibly be either URUSVATI HIMALAYAN RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF ROERICH MUSEUM, or URUSVATI HIMALAYAN AMERICAN SCIENTIFIC STATION OF ROERICH MUSEUM. The only other possibility would be HIMALAYAN RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF ROERICH MUSEUM without the first word, URUSVATI.

I am enclosing stamped self-addressed envelope for reply, and thank you in advance for any information.
