Your Excellency,

In compliance with your expressed desire,
I have the honour to forward you the following statement
of the Institute's activities for the past period of four
weeks.

1. The Institute's Secretary at Naggar reports the completion of work on the foundation of the Bio-chemical Laboratory. Every effort is done to secure the required amount of timber.
2. Dr. Koelz has arrived to Leh on the 15th of August. By a telegram dated the 11th instant he reports splendid collections. His next destination is Zangskar.
3. A collection of Tibetan books, both medical and religious, has been started.
4. The collection of medicinal plants is in progress. The Institute's staff is assisted by two native doctors.
5. Work is progressing on the first two volumes of the series "Tibetica".
6. Mr. Pertzoff's Memorandum, which was submitted to yourself, was forwarded to New York.
7. The Office Secretary in New York took her vacation in July. The Institute's Journal is still in the Press.
