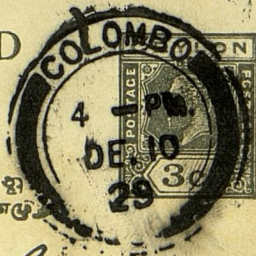



There is no cardboard in Naggar and the nearest shop 25 miles away only stocks very thin cardboard.

We need however some cardboard, of the thickness of the enclosed sample. Please send by V.P. POST 5 sheets of the enclosed thickness. I understand the usual size is 25"30", but the post office will not accept such sizes (and there is no railway near) therefore I request you to kindly cut them in half, making 10 boards 25"x15". Please protect edges and corners well and pack well in corrugated cardboard, as the mail is very roughly handled by the postal runners up hill here. I would perhaps even advise protecting the cardboard by some wooden boards from both sides.

Do you stock booksbinders' knives, for cutting cardboard etc, and sharp edged metal ruler, about 18" long? If so what is the price? I would appreciate receiving a catalogue if such is available. The metal ruler may be a kind of right angle piece, graded in inches.

A locking arrangement combined with the hand wheel, moving the front gauge, makes it possible in a simple manner that this front gauge can be adjusted perfectly parallel and firmly fixed from the place where the workman stands.

Together with a secure clamping arrangement (clamping beam, draw rods and treadle) an exact cutting of even large sized sheets is guaranteed.

For laying on and cutting very small pieces up to $5\frac{15}{16}$ " length, a corresponding piece in the clamping beam is left free towards the place of the operator.

Top and bottom knives are made of best tool steel and carefully ground. 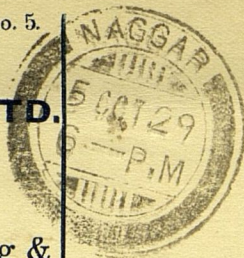

On arrival of the parcel we took immediately delivery being confident that you would not send us again the wrong chimneys and we were much supriedd on opening the box to find the useless chimneys again of which by the way one was also broken due to inediquate packing inbetween the two glasses, which struck against each other in transit. We have been expecting your letter of explanation and bill since, but nothing more is heard from you. As the postage on the parcel is more than the price of the chimneys, and as one of them is broken it is not even worth while to waste the postage for return to you. You have thus put us at a dead loss as for the amount paid and we expect that you either deliver us the proper chimneys as ordered with low one inch bases below the globural part, or that you credit us with the amount you have collected from us.

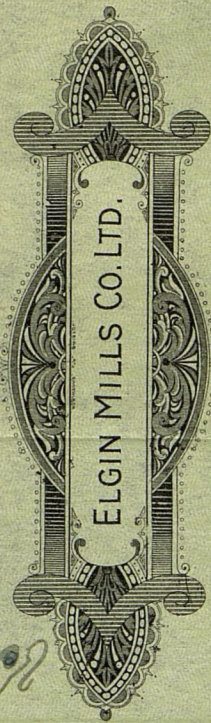

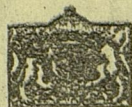
