Will you please therefore intimate in detail what is required and whether you have arranged with any Firm outside the Punjab Province for the importation of the alcohol made in India. The 5 gallons of alcohol you require can be imported from a Firm outside province only in case it is not obtainable in the Province.

Dear Sir,

We thank you for your reply of the 10th inst. #3731, addressed to Dr. Walter Koelz of this Institute.

The permission for purchase of alcohol, for which we requested you, refers to rectified spirit (standard B.P.) wanted for botanical analytical purposes. The amount we may require over the winter is about 5 gallons. There is no need to import it outside the Punjab, as we are informed that it is obtainable in Lahore and Amritsar, provided we have a permit to purchase same. Messrs Campbell and Smith in Lahore informed us that this permit is to be obtained from the D.C.'s Office, and it is for this permit to purchase rectified spirit from any of the dealers in the Punjab that we apply for.


Sir,

Exemption from the limit of possession of Denatured Spirit.

Registered under District No. 2

Subject to the conditions applicable to all licenses, published in Punjab Government Notifications Nos. 92, 93, 94 and 95, dated 15th January 1915, and in the Financial Commissioner's notification No. 26, dated 22nd January 1915, so far as they are applicable,

and to the special conditions below.

This license authorising the possession of denatured spirit in privileged quantities only in the premises herein specified, viz, *Raggar, Kulu, Kangra District.*

and for the period from *10. 2. 1932* to *31. 3. 1932* is granted to *the Director, Himachal Pradesh Research Institute,* of *Raggar, Kulu* in the district of *Kangra for the possession of denatured spirit upto 15 gallons.*

Special Conditions.

1. This exemption license extends only to the possession and use of, and not to the sale of, spirits rendered effectually and permanently unfit for human consumption.
2. The licensee may purchase denatured spirit from any licensed vendor thereof in quantities greater than one gallon at a time and may remove such spirit from a licensed distillery after obtaining the permit or pass required by the rules.
3. The spirit shall be kept on the licensee's premises and shall be used only in the preparation of medical compounds.
