LABEL ITEMS

- 1919 Lammergeyer. This huge vulture with a wing spread of 9 ft is almost always to be seen in the Himalayas, floating among the clouds. When prey is sighted, flocks congregate and in a wink even a large animal is devoured, even to the bones.
- 1920 Griffon. This is the King of the Mountain Birds of Prey. No other bird may approach its feeding table. Its nest is always placed on lofty crags, so inaccessible that few natives have ever seen it.
- 943 Owl. The Dusky Horned Owl is a common bird of the Plains and its mystic call is often continued through the night.
1855. Roller. The Roller with all its beauty has so raucous a voice that its presence is vexatious.
- 1 Galleen. The Galleen is one of the finest of Himalayan Game Birds. It keeps to the high mountains, seldom descending lower than 12000 ft and is wary enough to suit the most exacting sportman.
- 1467 Moorhen. This brilliant Bird is almost never to be seen. It keeps in the densest rushes and only its croaking voice announces its presence.
- 1887 Magpie. Like all its relatives, the Magpie is a rascal and is always on hand when fruit is ripe.
- 1882 Thrush. This is the songster par excellence of the Hills. Its vigorous clear notes of distinctly a modern turn are never to be forgotten.
- 1813 Parrot. The parrots go about in flocks and their voices and antics always attract attention.
- 1502 Barbet. Like birds of bright plumage in general, the barbet has little else to recommend him.
- 1810 Hoopoo. The Hoopoo is so quaintly marked and behaves with such gravity that it is not strange he figures in many of the folktales of the Hills.
- 1512 Kingfisher. Whenever there are fish, these beautiful birds are sure to be found.
- 1865 Redstart. Strictly a bird of the mountains the redstart keeps to the running water and is always to be met with where some cascade dashes down from the heights.
- 1800 Pigeon. The Snow Pigeon breeds in the high mountains and the huge flocks that gather in the grainfields are one of the sights of the region.
- 1914 Myna. The myna is noted for his versatile vocalization and is often caged. He is furthermore esteemed as a sure cure for cough if eaten in soup!
- 1525 Parrot. This parrot is often caged but is then interesting only for

its beauty. In Nature, the large flocks with their varied calls as they wheel in formation through the air, are colorful in the extreme.

286 Washerman. This stylish bird is named from its habits. It keeps always to running water.

1868 Tit. Tits always travel in flocks of at least ten and are the friendliest creatures in the mountains.

1162 Paster. The beautiful Pastor, like the other Starlings, consorts in huge flocks and takes heavy toll on the grain. When locusts swarm, it turns its attention to these and does much good.

1826 Flycatcher. The Flycatcher is a common and conspicuous bird of the Mountains.

REDDEER. The reddeer roams in herds, feeding on the crops and doing much damage. The females have short thin spikes.

BLACKBUCK. Though not so generally distributed as the Red Deer, this magnificent antelope occurs sometimes in droves of hundreds. The females are hornless.

Group 1. This Crane is one of the most picturesque of Indian birds. Huge in size, loud in voice and dignified in bearing, it is by the natives regarded sacred and ~~neglected~~ is never molested. Nevertheless the birds are always wary of strangers, but are easily domesticated and make delightful pets. The Titiri is a common resident gamebird. Its shrill piercing cry when long continued is maddening.

The Wagtail nests in high mountains but descends in winter to the Plains.

Group 2. The Imperial Sand Grouse breeds outside Indian confines but in winter occurs in huge flocks and furnishes excellent sport. The Pintail Sand Grouse breeds where found. Large flocks are also to be met. Both grouse are wary and are hunted on camels.

Group 3. The Monal is the grandest of the hill pheasants. It keeps well toward the snowlind, preferring the thickets of lavender rhododendrons for feeding and nesting. Though common, the bird is very difficult to kill. The natives prize the metallic crest plumes of the male. The Grosbeak is a common bird of the hights and is attracting attention with his pleasant whistle.

Group 4. These lovely little parrots frequent the lower levels of the mountains. Their voice is sweet and they make interesting pets. The Flycatcher floats like a breeze-wafted paper through the air. The female is brown, inconspicuous, with no magnificent tail.
