



In answer to your letter of November 28th, we would say that we hope you have now received our letter of October 28th, advising despatch of Baddeley's book, acknowledging receipt of your note for Fcs.1000.- (£8) and advising that the books by Moule, Suzuki and Baur had been sent to Paris. These books were sent to Paris on the 3rd October, and as you were still in Paris on the 10th October, we think you should have received them before you left. We trust they have now come to hand.

The Baddeley was sent to India as you requested, and we hope you have since received it, and have remitted to us its full price as promised. When this book was offered for cash on receipt, we naturally expected to get cash from Paris, and in any case we expected that you would send us a cheque in full payment not later than your arrival in India. Our profit on the transaction was only about 5%, and as the amount has been outstanding over two months now, you will see that there is practically no profit in it for us.

At the same time our Headquarters point out that your account amounts to £54.8.9, and as money is very scarce at the present time, we should be greatly obliged if you could see your way to send us an early cheque for a part of the old account, as well as payment for the Baddeley.


