### Bibliography of Low Temperature Relations of Plants

The University of Minnesota is considering the publication of an "Annotated Bibliography of the Low Temperature Relations of Plants," by R. B. Harvey, Ph.D., of the Division of Plant Pathology and Botany, University Department of Agriculture. Publication will depend on the receipt of a sufficient number of conditional subscriptions in advance.

The bibliography will contain about 200 pages, octavo. The entries have all been classified alphabetically under the authors. Its compilation has been in progress for more than fifteen years. For the last five years, most of the time has been spent in checking citations by obtaining the original articles, translating when necessary, and correcting the form of the citation. The form of citation has been kept as uniform as possible, the system and abbreviations of the Library of Congress, with some modifications, being used. In some cases it has been necessary to Anglicize the characters of the Slavonic languages. Titles of articles in languages other than English have been translated. If the title of any article is not indicative of the contents of the article, annotations supply the omission.

The author acknowledges assistance from Dr. A. J. Pieters, principal agronomist of the Office of Forage Investigations, United States Department of Agriculture, and other members of the staff of that department; the Institute of Applied Botany, Leningrad, Russia; Cambridge University, England; Dr. E. Schnaffnit and Dr. Hans Fitting of the Institut für Pflanzenkrankheiten, University at Bonn, Germany; Dr. N. A. Maximov, Leningrad; F. R. Gevorkiantz and Mrs. E. Wilde of the Lake States Forest Experiment Station, St. Paul, Minnesota, and the many students who have worked on this problem at the University of Minnesota. European references which are not available in the United States were read and checked with the originals in 1927-28 when the author was a fellow of the John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Foundation.

It is believed that this bibliography will be of great value to students in locating citations of the literature of this subject, and that it will so encourage interest in and study of the subject that research will be more quickly advanced.

The book will be bound, probably, in stiff paper and the price will not be more than \$2.00 a copy. The sale of at least 500 copies at this price will be necessary in order to cover the cost of publication. Therefore, it will be necessary to obtain a satisfactory number of "conditional orders" before printing can be undertaken.

#### NEW ENGLAND'S PROSPECT: 1933

[500 pages; 48 maps and diagrams]

A VOLUME OF PAPERS BY TWENTY-SEVEN AUTHORS

The first extended description of New England was William Wood's "New England's Prospect" published in London in 1634. Its title has been revived by the Society for a book dealing with a far more complex New England than that visited by Wood three hundred years ago. In "New England's Prospect: 1933" twenty-seven authors discuss from as many points of view various aspects of contemporary life in one of the oldest and most distinctive sections of the United States. They seek for the roots of some of the more serious problems that the people of New England are facing. Their interest lies also in the future and in how it is to be metin what we today call New England's prospects.

In the opening article Dr. James Truslow Adams interprets New England character in the light of history. Other introductory articles deal with the regions into which New England may be divided and with New England's industrial position in the nation and its prospects in the large. Mr. Edward A. Filene contributes a paper on fundamental factors in the unemployment situation. The main part of the book consists of articles on specific problems in connection with food supply, agriculture, forestry, fisheries, hydroelectric power, manufacturing, transportation, trade, rural and urban sociology, state and local government, and regional planning. Among the contributors may be mentioned Dean Henry S. Graves of the Yale School of Forestry, Professor William J. Cunningham of Harvard, Dr. Lewis Radcliffe, Deputy Commissioner

#### MAPS OF HISPANIC AMERICA

Last year a surprisingly large number of Fellows found the Society's great map of Hispanic America in 100 sheets particularly useful. This year there are a number of new sheets available in addition to those previously listed for distribution. Everyone who has seen them marvels that maps of such high quality have been produced in this country. The sheets are part of the International Map of the World, 1:1,000,000, in the production of which geographers and governments have so long participated.

Any two sheets of the millionth map may be requested in place of one of the books described herewith. Two new sample sheets are described below. An index map showing the location of the published sheets and giving a complete list of titles will be sent on request to any Fellow who would like a wider range of selection.

- 1. San Luis Potosí. This sheet covers an important section of the principal rail, motor, and air-transportation routes between the United States and Mexico City, and travelers by any of these routes will find it the most detailed map available for a large part of their journey. The sheet also covers the whole of the famous Tampico oil-fields.
- 2. Comodoro Rivadavia. This sheet extends from the Chile-Argentine boundary, in one of the most picturesque sections of the lake region of the Patagonian Andes, to the Gulf of San Jorge on the Atlantic Ocean and, because of many new surveys incorporated, shows in excellent detail the topography of the great basaltic mesas of southern Patagonia. The area between the Gulf of San Jorge and Lakes Colhué-Huapi and Musters, covered by the sheet, is not only one of the most important in the Argentine Patagonia from the standpoint of recent agricultural colonization but is also the center of an important petroleum development.



seen the plains of India as they stretch away to the furthest horizon. Whatever the trials of the road in bygone days, the traveller found solace and reward in the beautiful view from Sisagarhi.

From Sisagarhi there is a climb of a few hundred feet to the top of the Chisapani Pass, from where the first glimpse of the snows is obtained. From here the path falls steeply to the Panoni river through country of great beauty at all seasons of the year, whether the sides of the road are gay with bushes of pink mimosa, or resplendent in their spring clothing

of rhododendron and wild apple blossom.

Perched on some smooth patch of grass above the path, at intervals of a few miles, are rough shelters where some enterprising and commercially-minded Nepalese dispense light refreshments to thirsty and footsore wayfarers. The diet offered is unpretentious; highly sweetened and strong-flavoured tea being the most popular, if not the only, item on the bill of fare. Leaving their loads in serried line propped up against the banks of the track, the sturdy coolies squat round the open-air kitchen, sipping their hot tea and puffing at their cigarettes with an air of supreme contentment. At that moment they are at peace with themselves and all the world.

A soldier on leave from a Gurkha regiment in India, who is "trekking" to his home, some three marches beyond Kathmandu away to the west, joins the group. He is sturdily built and smart in his well-fitting black coat and shorts. The coloured tops of his stockings are of a brightness that even the most daringly-garbed devotee of plus-fours in Europe would tremble to affect. Here, however, they do not seem exaggerated or out of place; the little soldier with his cap set at a jaunty angle, and his treasured khukri slung bandolier-wise by a red cloth, presents a debonair and pleasing appearance. To the coolies, he is essentially a "man of the world"; and his stories of life in his cantonment and the big teeming cites of India—possibly somewhat highly coloured—are listened to with silent respect. The comely damsel of the inn, who ministers to his wants, glances
