Gentlemen:

Action has been deferred on the application received from you for registration of the "Journal of Urusvati Himalayan Research Institute" (published August 3, 1931) because there is a question as to the correct form of the copyright owner's name. The application gives Urusvati, Himalayan American Scientific Station, but the name appears in the notice of copyright on the copies as Urusvati Himalayan Research Institute of Roerich Museum, and it would seem that this latter form is correct. Please give us a statement on the enclosed white card as to the full legal form of this name, and if the present application is wrong, file a new one.

You have applied for registration of this work under class "A" of the law as a book, but as it is described as a "Journal" the question has arisen as to whether publication is to take place at regular intervals. If the Journal is to be published regularly as a periodical, then it would come under class "B" of the law, and application should be made on form B-1 enclosed.
