

Sir,

In reply to your note of the 24th inst. #S.B.Smithsonian of 1931-32, we beg to request to forward the Publications of the Smithsonian Institute to us by parcel post, NAGGAR only being a postal station.

In case they are however too heavy for despatch by post, the case will have to be sent carefully packed to protect against rough handling on the motor road, to KULU OUTAGENCY North Western Railway (via Jogindarnaggar NWRy.) but this procedure is connected with much inconvenience, Kulu Outagency being 16 miles away from here. We would thus prefer delivery by PARCEL POST, which is delivered to the Institute's premises.
