Your letter No.422-L dated the 22nd July. The only official map of a tract of country, such as that comprising the Chaki nullah, are these issued by the Survey of India, but in this case no sheet for a scale larger than $\frac{1}{2}$ inch to a mile has been published.

For definite field numbers copies of the revenue maps can be obtained from the Record Room at Naggar Castle. A rough map of any particular stretch of cultivated land along the Chaki can therefore be compiled but the actual bed of the stream is not shown in the revenue plans.
